Students may use financial aid toward items included on the Cost of Attendance for each period of enrollment. Direct Costs include tuition and fees which are estimates of direct charges that will reflect on the summer billing statement. There may be differences between the actual charges and these estimates based on fees specific to certain factors like colleges, majors, courses, housing, or type of meal plan chosen. The remaining items represent estimates of indirect costs for educationally related out-of-pocket expenses. In other words, these costs will not show up on the bill, but students may still have these other expenses due to enrolling in courses. If you decide to live on campus, or purchase a meal plan, then these costs will show up on your bill. If not, these costs will depend on your spending.

The Virginia Tech Board of Visitors sets tuition, fees, and other charges annually. The tuition and fees for the summer are usually set during the fall board meeting.
