The Cost of Attendance (COA) below represents an estimate of the total cost of attend Virginia Tech for one academic year (Fall & Spring).

**Direct Cost**

**Indirect Cost** 

An estimate of the out-ofpocket expenses a student may have but does not pay for directly on the bill. These vary by student!

The COA for first time graduate students include a computer budget of \$2,150, or \$3,140, depending on the program. Students that use Federal Student Loans to help cover their costs will see a \$200 direct loan fee budget item. Most graduate students that complete a <u>Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)</u>, qualify for an <u>Unsubsidized Direct Loan</u> of \$20,500. Additional funding, up to the full COA, minus other financial aid, can be obtained through a <u>Graduate PLUS Loan</u>.

<u>Graduate Assistantships</u> are considered other sources of financial aid and can reduce initial

loan amounts!
