

The Cost of Attendance (COA) below represents an estimate of the total cost of attend Virginia Tech for one academic year (Fall & Spring).

There may be differences

between your actual charges and these estimates!

An estimate of the out-ofpocket expenses a student may have but does not pay for directly on the bill. These vary by student!

The COA for first time graduate students include a computer budget of \$2,150, or \$3,140, depending on the program. Students that use Federal Student Loans to help cover their costs will see a \$200 direct loan fee budget item. Most graduate students that complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), qualify for an Unsubsidized Direct Loan of \$20,500. Additional funding, up to the full COA, minus other financial aid, can be obtained through a Graduate PLUS Loan. Graduate Assistantships are considered other sources of financial aid and can reduce initial

loan amounts!
