There can be differences between your actual charges and these estimates based on fees specific to certain Colleges or Majors and individual choices of Housing, Meal Plan and Lab fees required for certain courses.

Books, Travel, and Miscellaneous are variable, out-of-pocket expenses that will not be included on your billing statement. These charges will vary by student. Loan fees is the average amount of loan fees incurred by all students for Federal Direct Loan funds during the 2017-18 academic year.

Most Professional students that complete a FAFSA are eligible for an Unsubsidized Direct Loan of \$40,500 per year. Additional funding, up to the full COA less other financial aid can be obtained through Graduate PLUS Loans. Scholarships are counted as 'other financial aid' and can reduce initial loan awards.
