Books, Transportation, and Personal are variable, out-of-pocket expenses that will not be included on your billing statement. These charges will vary by student. Loan fees are the average amount of loan fees incurred by all students for Federal Direct Loan funds during this academic year.

Most Professional students that complete a FAFSA are eligible for an Unsubsidized Direct Loan of \$40,500 per year. Additional funding, up to the full COA less other financial aid, can be obtained through Graduate PLUS Loans. Scholarships are counted as 'other financial aid' and can reduce initial loan awards.
