August 7, 2017 through December 7, 2017.*

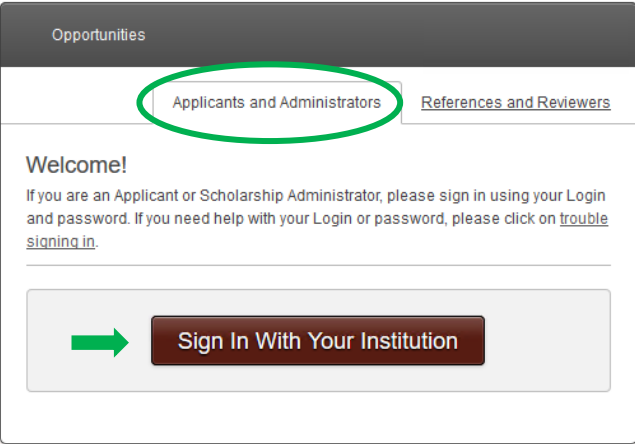
*Certain conditional applications and apply-to scholarships will have different open dates and deadlines.

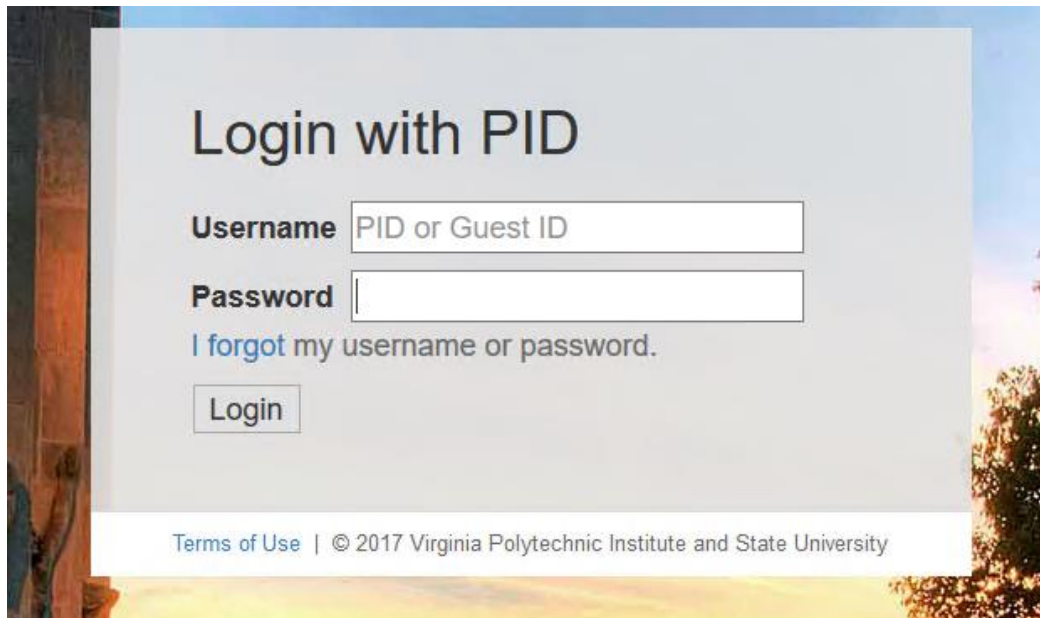
Prospective Students:

1. Apply for admission to VT at <http://admissions.vt.edu/apply.html>

Returning Students:

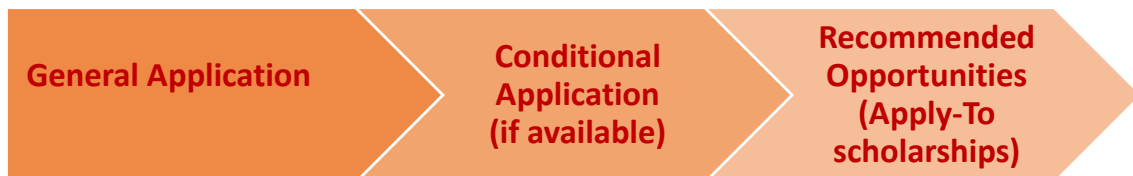
1. Log in to the VT Scholarship Central using your VT PID username and password at <https://vt.academicworks.com/>

2. Complete and submit the **Conditional Application if applicable** (e.g. College of Science). Note: Some colleges will not have a required application. There may be a few department-level applications available as well.

The College of Science scholarship application is available to all students majoring within the College of Science.

You will be required to include a personal statement/essay. The Writing Center has a variety of resources available. For more information, please visit <http://www.lib.vt.edu/spaces/writing/students.html>. Please have someone proofread your essay before submitting it.

Resume

Typically, a resume will contain the following:

- Your current educational status (e.g., student at Virginia Tech; year started; your anticipated degree; your major; current overall GPA)
- Awards/Honors
- Your research involvement (if applicable); name of laboratory and your research supervisor; how long have you (did you) work in this lab; brief description of your duties and skills acquired as a function of this experience; any papers/presentations from your research work
- On-campus organizations, especially if they involve leadership training/experience
- Off-campus organizations, especially if they involve leadership training/experience
- Employment (current and past); nature of the job; when and where
- Volunteer experience (current and past); nature of the job; when and where

Please have someone proofread your resume before submitting it. The Career Service Center has a variety of services available to assist students in resume writing. Prospective Students:

Prospective students should be able to log in to VT Scholarship Central after 3 business days of applying for admission.

- Day 1 – Apply for admission
- Day 2 – Create a Guest Account
- Day 3 – Log in to Scholarship Central

Current Students:

Populating a Conditional Application

All students will see the General Application.

Conditional Applications (College or Department-level applications) **will not appear for prospective students until the General Application has been submitted and you have selected a college on the General Application.**

Some students may not see a Conditional Application. (Some colleges are not using one, or the application may not be open at that time.) Conditional Applications are typically used at the College-level, but a few departments (e.g., Department of Accounting & Information Systems) will have their own application.
