ALL students who want to be considered for any scholarships (general scholarships and departmental scholarships) must complete these steps.

Scholarship applications are available for the **2018-2019** year from:

August 7, 2017 through December 7, 2017.

Prospective Students:

1. Apply for admission to VT at <http://admissions.vt.edu/apply.html>
2. Create a Guest Account using their 9 digit application ID number from Step 1. For more information on the Guest Account and FAQs, please visit <http://admissions.vt.edu/apply/guest-account.html>
3. Use the Guest Account login credentials to log in to the VT Scholarship Central (AcademicWorks system) at finaid.vt.edu → Scholarship Central (<https://vt.academicworks.com/>)

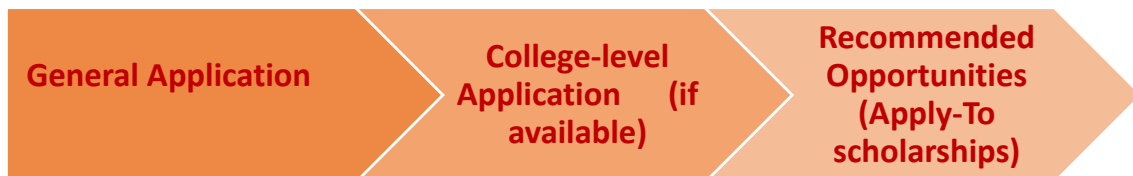

Prospective Students:

Prospective students should be able to log in to VT Scholarship Central after 3 business days of applying for admission.

- Day 1 – Apply for admission
- Day 2 – Create a Guest Account
- Day 3 – Log in to Scholarship Central

After this, if students are unable to log in, confirm the following:

1. Student is able to log in to the Guest Account
If not, direct them to the Guest Account FAQs page for more information.

2. Student is using the same email and password to log in to Scholarship Central as they use to log in to the Guest Account.
3. Request student to send a screen shot of the error message to finaid@vt.edu. These will be added to Chelsey's and/or Andrew's email box for review and the student will be notified of resolution shortly.

Current Students:

Current students should be able to log in to the VT Scholarship Central beginning August 7.

If students are unable to log in, confirm the following:

1. Student's VT PID username and password are working. For example, are they able to log in to HokieSPA?
2. Student is using the same VT PID username and password to log in to Scholarship Central.
3. Request student to send a screen shot of the error message to finaid@vt.edu. These will be added to Chelsey's and/or Andrew's email box for review and the student will be notified of resolution shortly.

Populating a Conditional Application

All students will see the General Application.

Conditional Applications (College or Department-level applications) **will not appear for prospective students until the General Application has been submitted and they have selected a college on the General Application.**

Some students may not see a Conditional Application (some colleges are not using one.) Conditional Applications are typically used at the College-level, but a few departments (e.g., Department of Accounting & Information Systems) will have their own application.

Conditional Applications can be populated in two ways:

1. **Current students'** college listed in Banner will prompt the corresponding Conditional Application (if one exists.)
 - a. If for some reason the student's conditional application is not populated, (first confirm the college/department has an application), he/she may go back to the general application and select the College in which they will be enrolled and re-submit the application. (The wording of this question is targeted to prospective students.)
2. **Prospective students** must select the College to which they are applying from the drop down menu on the General Application in order to populate that Conditional Application.
