

Scholarship Tips

- Students are encouraged to complete their Admissions application by December 1st to be given full consideration for institutional scholarships.
- File your FAFSA on www.fafsa.gov by **March 1st**.
- **Do not wait for your admissions decision to apply for scholarships.**
- Make sure to apply for scholarships for your first **AND** second choice major.
- Many scholarship application deadlines fall between December 15th and March 1st, so make sure to check for your department deadlines.

Scholarship Deadlines

- **College of Agriculture and Life Science** – scholarship application due March 1st.
- **College of Architecture and Urban Studies**- no additional application required. All students accepted will be considered.
- **College of Engineering** – many scholarships do not require a specific application. The Davenport Scholarship deadline will be in mid to late January.
- **College of Liberal Arts and Human Sciences** – no additional application required. All students accepted will be considered.
- **College of Natural Resources and Environment** - Application is through the Scholarship Gateway and the deadline is February 15th.
- **College of Science** – Application is through the Scholarship Gateway and the deadline is February 15th
- **Pamplin College of Business** – no additional application required. All students accepted will be considered.
- **University Honors** – priority deadline to be considered for Honors Scholarships is December 1st. To be considered you must complete application to University Honors
- **University General Scholarships** - Application is through the Scholarship Gateway and the deadline is February 15th
- **Presidential Campus Enrichment Grant**- Application is through the Scholarship Gateway and the deadline is February 15th
