Priority Deadline:

Return by **June 1, 2020** for maximum aid consideration.

The information you provide will be compared to the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). If there are differences, our office will submit corrections to your FAFSA electronically. This instruction sheet is for you to keep for your records.

In the first section of this form, you, the student, will confirm your marital status and the date this status became effective.

In the next section of the form, you, the student, will clarify your tax filing status. You must submit your 2018 **federal tax return transcript** or a **signed** copy of your 2018 federal tax return (1040), including all schedules, that you filed with the IRS. The remainder of the form collects and clarifies federal tax return information.

Below are a couple of options for requesting a transcript. It may take up to two weeks for IRS income information to be available for electronic IRS tax return filers and six to eight weeks for paper IRS tax return filers.

If you and or your spouse (if applicable) are not <u>required</u> by law to file a federal tax return you will need to provide the following:

- A copy of IRS Form W–2 for each source of 2018 employment income received or an equivalent document such as the Wage and Income Transcript. Wage and Income Transcripts can be obtained at www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript; and
- 2. IRS Verification of 2018 Non-filing Letter dated on or after October 1, 2019.

An IRS Verification of Non-filing Letter can be obtained online using the IRS Get Transcript service. If the individual cannot obtain one online, it must be requested by mail. Check box 7 on the IRS Form 4506-T, Request for Transcript of Tax Return, and mail it to the IRS. If appropriate, a similar confirmation from another taxation authority (e.g., a U.S. territory or a foreign government) is also acceptable.
