To qualify for the scholarship, a student must be:

- 1. Otherwise Pell-eligible
- 2. Have a Pell-eligible EFC higher than 0
- 3. Be less than 24 years of age OR enrolled at an institution of higher education at the time of his or her parent's or guardian's death

Required Supporting Documentation

- Completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA may be submitted through fafsa.ed.gov. VT's school code is 003754.
- 2. Copy of student's birth certificate. DO NOT SEND ORIGINAL DOCUMENT
- 3. Copy of parent/guardian's death certificate. DO NOT SEND ORIGINAL DOCUMENT
- 4. Verification that parent/guardian died in the line of duty while serving as a public safety officer:
 - A determination letter acknowledging eligibility for certain federal benefits under the Public Safety Officers Benefit (PSOB) program administered by the Department of Justice; OR
 - A written letter of attestation or determination made by a state or local government official with supervisory or other relevant oversight authority of an individual who died in the line of duty while serving as a public safety officer as defined above; OR
 - c) Documentation of the student qualifying for a state tuition or other state benefit accorded to the children or other family members of a public safety officer consistent with the definition in 42 U.S.C. 3796b, or as a fire police officer as noted above; OR
 - d) Other documentation from a credible source, subject to school determination, that describes or reports the circumstances of the death and the occupation of the parent or quardian.
- 5. If applying due to the death of a step-parent, a copy of a marriage certificate indicating the step-parent's marriage to the biological parent is also required.
- If the student was older than 24 at the time of the parent's death, a copy of an unofficial transcript or grade report from a college or university indicating the student was enrolled at the time of the parent's death is also required.
