#### Tax Document – Option #1 (preferred). Use IRS Direct Data Exchange (DDX) on the FAFSA:


As part of Federal student aid eligibility, parents will be required to consent and approve sharing and importing income and tax information from the IRS to the FAFSA form, even if the attempt to obtain or use such data is ineffective. In other words, if the parents filed separate 2023 IRS income tax returns, both must provide consent and approval to share and import income and tax information from the IRS. In most cases, no further documentation is needed to verify 2023 income information that was transferred into the student's FAFSA using income and tax information directly from the IRS via the FA-DDX.

Tax Document – Option #2. Requesting a 2023 IRS Tax Return Transcript if info was not transferred via FA-DDX and considered verified:

If you use this option, write the student's name and ID on the transcript before submitting it to our office.

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# **Additional Information for Special Tax Filing Situations**

#### Parent(s) not required to file a federal tax return provide the following for each Non-filer:

- A copy of IRS Form W–2 for each source of 2023 employment income received (or an equivalent document such as the Wage and Income Transcript). Wage and Income Transcripts can be obtained at www.irs.gov/individuals/gettranscript; and
- 2. IRS Verification of 2023 Non-filing Letter dated on or after October 1, 2024.

An IRS Verification of Non-filing Letter can be obtained online using the **IRS Get Transcript service**. If the individual cannot obtain it online, you must request it by mail. Check box 7 on the **IRS Form 4506-T**, *Request for Transcript of Tax Return*, and mail it to the IRS. If appropriate, a similar confirmation from another taxation authority (e.g., a U.S. territory or a foreign government) is also acceptable.

#### Individuals Who Filed an Amended 2023 IRS Income Tax Return provide:

- A transcript obtained from the IRS that lists 2023 tax account information of the tax filer(s); use of the IRS DDX on the FAFSA; or a signed copy of the filed 2023 tax return with all schedules;
   AND
- 2. A signed copy of the 2023 IRS Form 1040X, "Amended U.S. Individual Income Tax Return," that was filed with the IRS.
- 3. A signed copy of the 2023 IRS Form 1040 and the applicable schedules that were filed with the IRS

# Individuals required to file a 2023 IRS income tax return and were granted a filing extension by the IRS beyond the automatic six-month extension for tax year 2023 must provide the following:

- 1. A copy of the IRS's approval of an extension beyond the automatic six-month extension for tax year 2023; and
- 2. IRS Verification of 2023 Non-filing Letter dated on or after October 1, 2024; and
- 3. A copy of IRS Form W–2 for each source of 2023 employment income received or an equivalent document; and
- 4. If self-employed, a signed statement certifying the amount of AGI and U.S. income tax paid for tax year 2023.

### Individuals who were the victim of IRS tax-related identity theft are required to provide:

A 2023 Tax Return DataBase View (TRDBV) transcript obtained from the IRS, if unable to obtain a TRDBV, an
equivalent document provided by the IRS or a copy of the signed 2023 income tax return and applicable
schedules the individual filed with the IRS

#### AND

2. A statement signed and dated by the tax filer indicating that he or she was a victim of IRS tax-related identity theft and that the IRS has been made aware of the tax-related identity theft.
